REMINDERS

Drummond Dismissal Pick-up – Please do not park in the **private** parking lot on Drummond Place. It is so marked. Also, please do not park in or across the driveways of residences or double park and allow your children to enter the car from the street.

Winter Uniforms –All boys and girls in grades 5 through 8 are required to wear sweaters at all times. Only **green** knee socks are the uniform socks for girls. The only other leg

covering girls may wear are tights – green, blue, or white. Girls may wear the gym sweats under their jumpers or skirts on cold days but they must be removed once in school. As the weather gets colder, please be sure that students are dressed appropriately. Recess is outdoors whenever it can be. Students may not wear team sweat shirts in school. White socks only for gym.
