ENROLLMENT:

- Complete an enrollment form for **each** individual child in your family. Forms can be printed from the SJS website. Complete one form per child. Do not add a sibling's name to the form.
- Payment must be included with the completed form. Make check payable to *St. James School*. **Exception: \$50 cash payment must be made for the Babysitting club***. A separate check per child is required (e.g., if you have two children who are both enrolling for the same club, please send **two** separate checks.)
- Send completed forms with checks in **one** envelope marked "Clubs" to the Business Office. Send the envelope to school with your youngest child.
- Clubs fill up early and sizes are limited so send in your envelope as soon as possible, but no later than the **Deadline of Friday, February 15th**. Enrollment is given on a first come, first served basis.
- Your child's enrollment in a club is not guaranteed until you receive confirmation notification. If you do not receive notification prior to the start of the club, please contact us directly. Club participants can attend only on their chosen day (Tuesday *or* Thursday).

*** Babysitting club participants must make payment in CASH (\$50). This club is limited to the first 8 students who sign up. Participants must be at least 11 years old. Note that this club runs on a different date/time schedule: Wednesday Feb 27th, Thursday Feb 28th, Wednesday March 13th, and Thursday March 14th. Since certification is given after the completion of 8 hours instruction, it is necessary that this club run 2 hours each session from 2:30-4:30pm.**

DISMISSAL:

- On the days that the clubs are held, club participants will go directly to the gym at dismissal. Please send your child to school with an extra snack and a Change of Dismissal note indicating that they will go to "Clubs" and be picked up at **3:30pm** in front of the school. **A Change of Dismissal note must be completed for each day your child attends a club.**
- Parents may park in the school's parking lot or on the **school-side** of the street only. The Red Bank police department does not allow parking on the opposite side of the street.
- Parents are not permitted to enter the school for purposes of picking up a child from a club. Please remain outside by the front steps and your child will be brought out to you as each club is dismissed.

AMERICAN RED CROSS BABYSITTING CLUB: Hosted by Mrs. Marie Lehmann, R.N. This club offers basic training in CPR, first aid and baby care. Eight hours of instruction are required to receive certification from the American Red Cross. This club is limited to the first 8 students who sign up. Participants must be at least 11 years old.
