I haven't earned enough credit towards my fundraising dollars yet, or I'm not sure where I stand with my fundraising commitment. How do I get answers?

If I get family and friends to sponsor the event, does this count towards the fundraising commitment?

Yes, as long as your family name and the students name and homeroom is included on the sponsorship form. This way we know where to apply the funds.

I forgot to send in an All Access Pass Order Form, or we've already met our fundraising goals for this year, or we just can't afford to financially participate at this time. Will my child(ren) be unable to participate?

<u>ALL STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE FUN ON ARCADE DAY</u>. We are asking that money and forms be sent in with children in advance of the event in an envelope their homeroom teacher can send to the office. Come the day of the event, all children will attend, have all-access passes and get to participate.

I sent in a \$25 donation, and I checked the box that my student can receive the Individual Bag of Popcorn. Did I need to send in an extra \$1 over the \$20?

As long as we have the form with the box checked for Make Your Own Sundaes ($5^{th} - 8^{th}$ only) or Popcorn (all grades), and a minimum of \$1 per child per event was received, the student(s) will receive a ticket. We hope that the suggested donation might be increased for these events, as the cost to supply the food does come from our profits, but this is just a suggestion.

But I didn't send in any money, and I still checked the boxes for these two events. Does my student get a ticket for these two?

Students who do not financially participate will enjoy all the activities at Arcade Day, but a \$1 donation per student/per event for Make-Your-Own Sundaes ($5^{th} - 8^{th}$ only) and Popcorn (all grades) must be sent in preevent to participate in these two only. This is to help defray these costs.

Can my student pay the \$1 at the booth?

At this time, we are unable to accept any money during the event, but if we have enough volunteers on hand, we may set-up a ticket sale table for the two events only. Please consider volunteering!!! We will send an update in advance if we find we can accommodate this at the event.
