CELLULAR PHONE POLICY

If parents determine it is necessary for their child to have a cell phone for after school activities or in the case of an emergency to or from school, students may bring a cell phone into the building. However, cell phones must be turned off and placed in backpacks upon entering school. At the direction of the homeroom teacher, students are then to surrender their cell phones as soon as they enter the classroom where it is placed in a zip locked bag and brought to the Business Office for safe keeping for the day. At the end of the day, the cell phone is returned to the student and is to be placed immediately in the backpack where it is to remain until the student reaches home. The cell phone is to remain off.

If it is discovered that a student did not surrender the cell phone in the morning as directed, or the cell phone is not immediately placed in the backpack when returned at the end of the day, student may incur one of the following consequences: Lunch Detention, After School Detention, Cell Phone may be confiscated. Please note that the above list is **not** an all-inclusive list.

Saint James School is not responsible for lost or damaged cell phones. Cell phones should be labeled and placed in a protective case.
