#### **Opening Prayer**

Principal's Report: Mrs. Giordano

- Office Renovations not only did the office receive a complete makeover but it was necessitated for security reasons. Now the office is completely closed to outside traffic as well as limiting the amount of people who need to be in the office. A new license swiping procedure for access into the school has been implemented the office staff will now swipe the driver license before anyone can leave the lobby and enter into the school. There is also now a bin in the lobby for items that need to be dropped off to students during the school day.
- The Red Bank Police Department has officers who will come periodically at all times of the day to walk through the premises for a show of security.
- A new fence was installed across from the playground. For safety purposes, it is now higher than the previous fence.
